Works will be allocated into 5 different age groups- 4-6, 7 – 9, 10 -13, 14-17, 18 -21 years old.

A virtual exhibition of the jury's selected works will take place in September. The exact dates will be specified later.

The best works will be awarded with commemorative medals and diplomas.
